Good morning Parents and Carer/s

I hope all our families have had a wonderful Easter bonding together. I wish to acknowledge the Queensland Premier's ruling yesterday:

"From the start of Term 2 until 22 May 2020, all students will be learning from home, except for students in the following categories:

- Children of essential workers on days when they are not able to be supervised at home and no other arrangements can be made. Essential worker means any worker who must continue to attend their workplace for essential business during this time.
- Vulnerable children include children identified by schools or who:
  - are currently receiving services from Child Safety, including children who are subject to a child protection order
  - are subject to a youth justice order.
- Children in designated Indigenous communities.

Where the student is learning at home, the parent or carer is responsible for the student's safety and wellbeing at home or elsewhere."

Our teachers have made sure that all the lessons for Week 1 & 2 are planned and ready to go for the commencement of Term 2 through the Sharepoint platform.

I am awaiting final guidance from the Toowoomba Catholic Schools Office before sending out a letter tomorrow detailing all information for parents for the coming period of time.

Please note that those children who will be attending school will have various teachers, not necessarily their own class teachers, supervising them during the next 5 weeks.
